

Blewbury Community Chalk Streams (BCCS)

As part of Sustainable Blewbury's commitment to caring for all aspects of our village, we are supporting a new group who will be working with us to conserve, enhance and restore Blewbury's streams. BCCS is a volunteer group formed in May 2021 by scientists and lay people who care about the conservation of Blewbury's ancient chalk streams and the Cleve. Headed up by Camilla Burrow, Director of Wild Oxfordshire, this sub-group of Sustainable Blewbury will run a series of community events and also work with willing riparian owners, to care for and preserve our village waterways.
